



Find your high school

Your assigned high school will be based on your residence address. Check our address checker to see which school you're currently assigned to: <https://www.guhsd.net/Schools/Attendance-Boundaries/index.html>

We welcome you and your incoming 9th grade student, to the Grossmont Union High School District for the 2022-23 school year. Our goal is to make your student's transition to high school a smooth and welcoming experience. The following letter outlines the process to register your student for high school.

Note: the process of registering online is the first and most important step to receiving updates from your student's high school and for receiving future correspondence about options for your student. After you register online, you will create a Portal account that will allow you to monitor your student's progress through high school.

Your student's school of enrollment will be established after registration based on your legal residence. See other side for more information.

The first step to enroll your student in high school is to complete Online Registration and create an Infinite Campus Portal account. Here are the steps:

STEP 1 - Online Registration

Begin at www.guhsd.net and follow the links for Online Registration

Read your options and directions carefully, then complete an Online Registration for your student. When you are finished, and submit your information, district staff will review the data. Processing of your student's Online Registration application may take up to 10 business days.

STEP 2 - Create Portal Account

After your student's registration has been processed, you will receive an email stating that your registration has been approved.

Current/Previous GUHSD Parents: Your student will now be visible in your Infinite Campus Parent Portal.

New GUHSD Parents: Within 2 more business days, you will receive an email with a link for creating an Infinite Campus Parent Portal account. This account will allow you to check your student's grades, attendance, etc. It will also allow you to participate in School Choice.

Currently Scheduled School

The “Currently Scheduled School” is based on information that may be incorrect or out of date. Your student’s *actual* school of enrollment will be determined based on your legal residence as provided in the online registration and verified by proof of residency documentation.

Enrolling at a Charter School

Placement at Helix Charter or Steele Canyon High School, both California charter schools, is at the discretion of those schools. This letter is in no way a guarantee of admission to these schools. Please contact these schools directly for more information. If you intend on enrolling your student at either Helix or Steele Canyon, and do not wish to participate in Open Enrollment, you may disregard this notice.

Students with Disabilities

If your student receives special education services, please be aware that not every high school offers the same programs. Please contact the District’s Special Education administrative office if you have questions regarding special education at (619) 644-8115. **Note: transportation is not provided for school choice transfers.**
