GRADES

<u>Academic</u>: based on how well you demonstrate mastery of the 6th grade math & science standards in class. Assessments & projects are 50% of your academic grade & classwork makes up the remaining 50%...

*Assignments with a score of 70% or less can be revised in the tutoring center before/after school.

<u>Effort</u>: based on homework <u>completion</u> & extra effort shown in class such as active participation in both math & science.

<u>Citizenship</u>: reflects student behavior. Each student starts each week with 5 points. If a teacher warning needs to be given for being disrespectful/unprepared, a point will be lost.

✓ = verbal warning

 \checkmark = teacher conference & 5 minute detention

 \checkmark \checkmark = phone call home & 10 minute detention

More = teacher consequence (referral, parent conference, &/or detention.

CHROMEBOOKS & CELL PHONES

Chromebooks <u>must be charged to 80% or more every single day.</u> I will check chromebook charges each morning during homeroom. If you have less than an 80% charge, citizenship points will be taken away from your homeroom grade.
