Class Rules and Expectations:

The following class rules will be enforced at all times. Only YOU are responsible for your behavior:

1. Be in your seat and prepared to learn when the bell rings.
2. Raise your hand and wait to be recognized BEFORE you speak.
3. Show RESPECT. FOLLOW DIRECTIONS AT ALL TIMES.
4. Use appropriate/authorized websites only. No internet surfing.
5. Leave GUM, CANDY, and FOOD at home.
6. Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself; no horseplay allowed.

Attendance/Absences:

If you are absent, your parent must call the attendance office at 588-3617 (phone # is also in the student planner). Frequent absences will result in Parent Conference, and will affect your grade. Student is responsible for picking up missing work from absent folder in the classroom.

Assignments/Homework/Missed Work:

All classroom assignments must be completed in pencil or computer. Sloppy writing, dirty, stained, torn and/or crumpled paper will not be accepted. All work must have a proper heading at the top right hand corner of the paper. A proper heading is: Complete name, date, subject, and period. **Papers with no name will not be graded and discarded.** Students will receive homework throughout the week, which is written in their planner for each class. All homework must be turned in neatly completed on the following day that it was assigned. When a student does not turn in 3 assignments, parents will be notified and the student will be assigned a Detention. Assignments missed due to an absence are **NOT** excused. **Students have the equal number of days they were absent to make up the work without penalty.**

Detention will be served after school. Written notice of a 20+ minute detention will be forwarded to the parent via the student. Continual violation will result in lowered effort grade and ISS placement (In School Suspension). Detention days are to be determined.

Exams/Tests:

Students will be allowed to make-up exams that were missed due to an illness. The student must make arrangements with the teacher to take the test within 5 days of returning to school. Any test not made up will receive an “F” or “0” points. A student who receives an unsatisfactory grade (69% or less) on a test, may retake it for a maximum score of 70%.

Rewards:

Students who demonstrate appropriate behavior and academic excellence will receive special recognitions. They may include: positive phone calls home, Cougar Cards, Cougar Way Recognition, Extracurricular Activities, special recognition celebrations, and classroom money.

Guest Teachers:

Students who do not follow the visiting teacher’s directions may be given a Referral to the Assistant Principal for an appropriate consequence. We may call home to inform parents of the inappropriate behavior to explain the situation.
