Q	What is the calendar for the 2024/25 school year?				
Α	The first day of school is Wednesday, August 15, 2024 <u>CVUSD School Year Calendar</u>				
Q	What are Hillsdale's school/office hours?				
Α	School begins at 9:00 am and students are dismissed at 3:30 pm (2:30 pm on Mondays). Our front office is open from 8:30 am until 4:00 pm (2:45 on Mondays).				
Q	What are the drop off and pick up procedures?				
A	Drop Off: Students may enter our campus either at the Main Gate or at the Apolinaria Gate. Gates open at 8:45. Supervision before 8:45 is limited. Pick Up: Students may exit at either gate.				
Q	Where should I drop off my child if they are late to school?				
Α	If your child is late to school, they will need to check in at the front office.				
Q	What should I do if I need to pick my child up early OR if my child will be absent or tardy?				
A	We encourage all doctor, dentist, etc. appointments to be made after school hours but understand that this is not always possible. If you need to pick your child up early from school, please come to the front office with identification and our office staff will be happy to help. For safety reasons, students can not be picked up during their lunch period. Please plan to pick them up at least 30 minutes before or right after lunch.

Q	What does a middle school class schedule look like? How long is each class period?					
A	We follow a traditional bell schedule with 50 minute periods, except for Monday, which is a minimum day and dismissal is at 2:30pm 6th grade students are teamed - they have a math/science teacher and an English/history teacher. Seventh and eighth grade students have math, science, history and English. All students have a PE period and an elective.					
Q	What electives does Hillsdale offer? How will my child's elective be decided?					
A	Elective offerings will provide students with experiences in different interest areas/RIASEC themes. Your child received an elective interest survey from their 5th grade teacher to complete in the Spring. If your child did not complete the survey an elective choice will be reviewed when your student is enrolling. We have electives such as drama, band, orchestra, career explorations, art, Spanish, robotics and STEM. Many 6th grade students will be on an elective wheel so they can sample several of our exciting classes! Seventh and eighth grade students are able to participate in leadership electives like ASB and yearbook, as well.					
Q	What is my child allowed to bring to school?					
Α	Please look out for information from your student's individual teachers to learn more about what supplies will be needed. Other acceptable school items include: Chromebook/charger Backpack Lunch (if they will not eat the school lunch provided) Water bottle Our front office cannot guarantee your student will receive an item that you drop off for them during the school day. Please make sure your student has all of their supplies before they leave for school.					
Q	How can I help my child be successful on days he/she has PE?					
A	Students are required to wear PE uniforms, as students will be dressing out and using the locker rooms in PE this year. Students will be able to purchase their uniform during their PE class during the first week of school. For your student's safety, closed toe shoes must be worn. More information will be shared by your student's PE coach when the school year begins We encourage all students to bring a personally labeled water bottle each day.					
Q	Is breakfast available?					

Α	We will be offering breakfast to any student at no charge. Students will have the opportunity to pick up a warm or cold breakfast choice once the campus opens at 8:45am. Students will need their student ID to get a free breakfast and lunch.			
Q	What do I need to know about lunch?			
A	Lunch is 30 minutes and is free for all students. There are usually 2-3 lunch options. The school office cannot accept lunch deliveries for students. Students will not be released during their lunch period.			
Q	Do you offer honors classes? How can my child get into honors classes?			
Α	Honors will be offered in English and math at all grade levels, based on iReady and CAASPP test scores, citizenship, and academic performance			
Q	What should my child do if they need to visit the Health Office?			
A	If your child needs to visit the health office (for health concerns, medication, etc.), students will either notify their classroom teacher or complete a visit request through our virtual health office.			
Q	What is the cell phone policy for students on school campus?			
Α	Cell phones must be off and put away when at school.			
Q	When is Chromebook Hospital available?			
Α	Students may get Chromebook support during their Advisory class Tuesday through Friday. Teachers will direct students in need of support to our Chromebook Hospital, which is located on site.			
Q	How can I monitor my child's activities on their Chromebook?			
A	The Bocksi Parent Dashboard is available to all Cajon Valley families. Blocksi gives parents the flexibility to enforce some of their home policies such as bedtime and access to control over specific content. Q	My child is an incoming 6th grader or is new to Cajon Valley. How will my child receive their new Chromebook for school?			

- 6th grade students and students that are new to Cajon Valley will receive their new Chromebook during the second week of school.
- **Q** How will my child be graded?

Students will be receiving feedback on their progress and grades from their individual teachers. Additionally, progress reports or report cards will be provided every six weeks. Please check the Parent Portal to find your child's grades. You may also contact your child's teacher with any questions you may have throughout the year.

Since progress reports and report cards are available online, we will not be sending home a printed copy with your student.



If you applied by the deadline and have not received an email, please contact the Hillsdale Counseling Department at (619) 441-6186. If you applied after the deadline, please keep an eye out for the email and contact Hilldale Middle School when you receive it. Are there any after school sports or clubs? Q We are scheduled to attend Camp Cuyamaca March 31st- April 4th, 2025. 6th grade teachers help coordinate this and will begin to share information in late Fall. More to come on fee-based transportation for other students When will my student receive his or her schedule? Q Schedules are often being finalized right up until the last minute. Our goal is to provide families with access through Zangle of their student's schedule no later than the night before school begins. We will also have schedules available on the morning of the first day of school for any student who did not receive their schedule by email. What if there is a problem with my student's schedule? Schedule changes are not usually made in the first two-three weeks. Students can meet with a counselor after that time to discuss options.
