At the start of the 2024–25 school year, Bostonia Global utilized Prop 28 funding to support a dedicated visual and performing arts program. The school employed one full-time certificated educator specializing in visual arts, media arts, theater, and music. Through this program, students engaged in rich artistic experiences that fostered creativity, collaboration, and self-confidence.

Over the course of the year, 780 students, ranging from transitional kindergarten through sixth grade, actively participated in Prop 28-funded arts instruction. These opportunities not only enhanced students' ability to express themselves but also developed critical thinking and problem-solving skills essential for future success. By integrating arts into Bostonia Global's competency-based and pathway-driven model, students were able to connect their artistic learning to broader academic and career goals.
