State Requirements for ELAC

Education Code 52176(b):

- All schools with twenty-one (21) or `more English Learner (EL) students, not including Reclassified Fluent English Proficient (RFEP) students, are required to establish an English Learner Advisory Committee (ELAC).
- All parents with EL students attending the school in which the ELAC is established are eligible and should be encouraged to participate in the ELAC.



Preparing our kids for College



- Parents of (RFEP) Reclassified Fluent English
 Proficient students are eligible to become
 ELAC officers.
- All ELAC officers **must be** parents of:
 - EL students or
 - o RFEP students
- ELAC officers cannot be employed by the District
- A member shall hold only one (1) officer position at a time.
- Officers cannot serve at two schools during the same school year.

ELAC Bylaws

• ELAC must use bylaws provided by the District.

 Bylaws may never conflict with federal, state, or District policies, rules and regulations.
