You are invited to apply to be a member of the team of the Hillsdale Middle School WEB Leaders! WEB Leaders are 8th graders who are good role models for younger students; students who have proven themselves as being successful at our middle school. A WEB Leader possesses communication skills, leadership potential, responsibility, personality and experiences that can be used to mentor younger students on the same path. You could have a tremendous influence on our new students, and you will learn many valuable leadership skills in the process. Plus, it will be FUN!

What does a WEB Leader do? WEB Leaders are trained to work with the incoming sixth graders and other new students who are entering our school next fall. After the extensive training, the WEB Leaders will run sixth grade orientation before school starts in August. At the orientation, each WEB Leader will be given a small group of sixth graders to work with that day and will be asked to befriend and to help that group during the first week of school with any challenges they may face. Additionally, through the school year, WEB Leaders will meet again with their student groups to touch base, discuss problems and plan social activities. We know that the more contact a sixth grader has with his/her WEB Leader, the more successful the sixth grader will be.

“Elective”—which is an all-year elective class next year
OR

“Non-Elective”—which is the summer institute and orientation only. You may take another elective and still be a part of the WEB program next year.
