David asked the group for any topics to discuss. One topic was that Transportation is not notified when a cohort get quarantined.

David asked if there are any ideas to get more parent voices.

Ms. Wood shared the time of meetings are important. Mornings are not good.

David shared some parents want old EDP model but limited. We have added employee children.

Ms. Wood shared 5 days a week would ease EDP concerns as she helps in EDP if needed.

Stephnie shared teachers are not comfortable with 25 per class. As COVID numbers go up, parents are keeping kids at home.

David shared the cap is 25 but hope to staff lower in the future.

Michelle Hayes shared the positive cases were not related to school. The County Public Health has commended our district for our safety practices.

Brandon asked if we are bound to the CDC and county guidelines.

David shared we are and we use the guidelines. Masks is the safest. Communal eating are the spreads. The latest order is wise for the winter recess.

Christina for lunch and communal eating we will need extra space if the number of students will go up.

Jennifer shared since we are the only school open in their area, they anticipate a lot of transfers from local districts.

David shared we need to accommodate community and maintain standards of safety.

Michelle Hayes shared staff and students have been very diligent in cleaning and safety.
