What is currently working?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● DL - breakout rooms help individual focus● Choice to choose DL or Hybrid● Goal Setting in class/ raffle incentives● Settling into a routine - helpful to know what's coming next● Incentive awards and being held accountable and hearing the teachers say the work is done● Teachers working hard / doing a great job● Teachers give individual focus for their children● Keeping close contact with parents● Some options to write on paper/pencil rather than typing online● Choice for all the different family situations● DL and in extended day● CHOICE for DL and In-person
What is not currently working?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● DL - Physical activity is lacking● DL Printing legibly - online typing and fewer opportunities for writing● Peer interaction● Teaching children traits like kindness and socializing with peers● Amount of screen time is daunting● Social time with peers● DL children but would do better in-person.
What should we try to improve?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Goal setting, motivation, and incentives for physical activity● More "doing" activities for DL students that aren't online

What conditions would make you comfortable to bring your child back to school? (most of parents on this zoom are DL)

- Move to a lower tier and things to improve in the community
- People getting vaccinated - Knowing the teachers getting vaccinated
- Worry about the vaccine - understanding that teachers may be leery to get it yet
- Wait until things are ideal before I bring my children back because my situation is different (able to support my children at home).
- Smaller class size in person 5 days a week.
- Worrying about Asymptomatic cases
- See how things go after Winter Break

What is currently working?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Communication between the teacher and parents/send messages to parents● Alerts coming from teacher in GC regarding work and academics● Quick response from teachers when parents reach out● Fun science projects DL● Creative games with students on DL
What is not currently working?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Difficulty for students to socialize while in distance learning● Handwriting, penmanship practice● Difficulty motivating students at home to produce work and retain information taught● Conductivity issues, IT problems, Navigating computer programs for learning● Work production for students who are working at home alone● Difficulty for students with attention issues staying focused and able to work independently
What should we try to improve?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● More instructional time at school
What should we stop doing?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Putting too many demands on students to produce independent asynchronous work
What conditions would make you comfortable to bring your child back to school?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● When Chase states they are ready, parent is ready (they trust the school)● Small class size (remain the same as it is now)● County cases significantly reduced

What is not currently working?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Difficulty for families during pandemic, lost jobs● Face to face with teacher● Not enough socialization for DL learners● Missing outside activities in the community● Not enough physical activity for DL learners● Staying home is difficult with DL learner
What should we try to improve?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● More homework and assigned● Difficulty for students to complete work independently● Teacher meetings in person with DL students periodically
