What's working?	-Smaller class sizes and teachers rotating, rather than students, for in-person learning -Students receiving live instruction in subject areas daily in Distance Learning model -Good communication from school to home -Appreciate district offering choice of Hybrid or Distance Learning -Students/parents/teachers adjusting and settling into routine
What's not?	 -Asynchronous days are challenging for Hybrid learners -Distance Learners are experiencing lots of screen time (asynchronously/hw) in addition to regular synchronous schedule -Desire for Hybrid students to see their teachers more often, but without any disruption to current schedules -Not having one place for students and parents to see when assignments are due for each class and housing of different resources -Inability to change learning model (i.e. from Hybrid to Distance Learning); waitlist for changing learning model has too many unknowns
