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| What's working? | <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Students being back on campus!<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Students love coming to school and playing with their friends○ Students come home from school happy and excited about their day○ Children value interactions with the other students, teachers, and staff● From the parents<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Teachers respond quickly to parent emails and messages○ Parents appreciate the patience and time staff spend educating families (new policies, procedures, and technology)○ Parents are grateful for all the commitment and effort put forth by teachers○ Parents value teacher created checklists that support child's completion of asynchronous work○ Communication from the school and teachers is very helpful and appreciated○ Parents value smaller class sizes<ul style="list-style-type: none">■ Students are provided more independent and personal time with teachers● Thank you teachers, staff, Mrs. Pacini, and Mrs. Dodds!!! |
| What's not? | <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Monday Zoom and Hybrid are overwhelming for both parents and students<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Feel disconnected○ Difficult to keep engaged○ Difficult for certain behaviors○ Too lengthy● Too much screen time in both in person and distance● Parents and students are struggling on Asynchronous days |

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| | <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Independent study, lack of parent presence/support at home is challenging○ Have to catch students up on work that is not being completed at their day care /EDP at the end of the night |
| What should we try to improve? | <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Some parents and students would like to see school 5 days a week● A few families shared that the current hybrid model works for their family● Parents would like to see students spend less time on screens● Tracking attendance multiple times throughout the day seems to take a lot of learning time away (ex: for rotations or when returning from a break)● Providing optional times for Distance Learners to meet with teachers weekly in person |
