What's not?	 Monday Zoom and Hybrid are overwhelming for both parents and students Feel disconnected Difficult to keep engaged Difficult for certain behaviors Too lengthy Too much screen time in both in person and distance Parents and students are struggling on Asynchronous days

	 Independent study, lack of parent presence/support at home is challenging Have to catch students up on work that is not being completed at their day care /EDP at the end of the night
What should we try to improve?	 Some parents and students would like to see school 5 days a week A few families shared that the current hybrid model works for their family Parents would like to see students spend less time on screens Tracking attendance multiple times throughout the day seems to take a lot of learning time away (ex: for rotations or when returning from a break) Providing optional times for Distance Learners to meet with teachers weekly in person
