Not having water fountains on and worrying about kids not having cold water on warm days without having to lug/carry a big jug of ice water! Or packing ice water bottles in a backpack and having them sweat all over their papers inside. The start time and the days he's on his own. It's been really hard working opposite shifts and not having edp and my son struggles with "independent" learning he does so much better being guided by a teacher esp in the classroom 2day attendance*****  <u>DL Parent</u>--It's really hard at home I think what's not working is that distance learning at home is a distraction to kids. some parents are not home all day and can't monitor kids all the time. they are home all day that it's easy for us parents to want to take them on our errands and forget they have work on line.</p>
