What's working?	I'm happy my daughter is coming to school every day. She is learning more now that she attends school 5 days a week, knows her vowels, letters and counts 1-35. Learning more in person, she learns more in depth and shares what she learns. Understands more than when she is in front of the screen. I'm happy it is open and that my child can attend 5 days per week in person, I don't think DL works for a 4 year-old. Social skills are an important part of Preschool. Pick up and drop off is working well. Seesaw is working. Great communication tool between parents and teachers.
What's not?	Online does not work, we would have problems with the Internet or the wifi. Jamacha - link to join the class doesn't work. My daughter was not benefiting from DL. She loves to socialize and learns better when she is around other children. The parent connection to the classroom is missing. Only thing I miss is being able to see what is going on. We don't know how the classroom is set up, I miss volunteering and participating in classroom activities.
What should we try to improve?	To improve, I would like my daughter to learn something new each day, it seems like it is repetitive.
