since 2010*

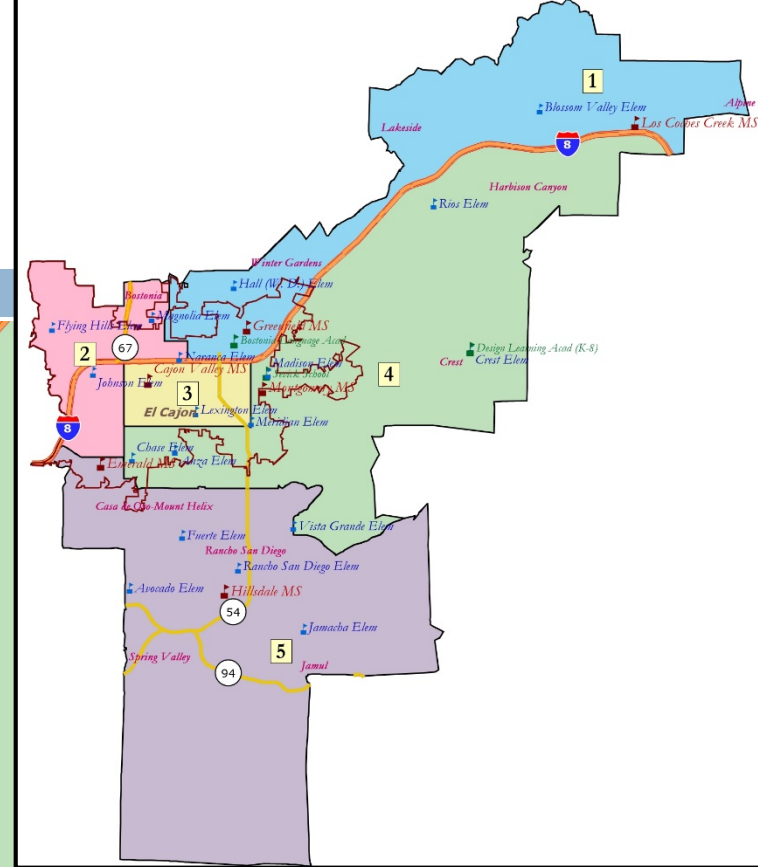
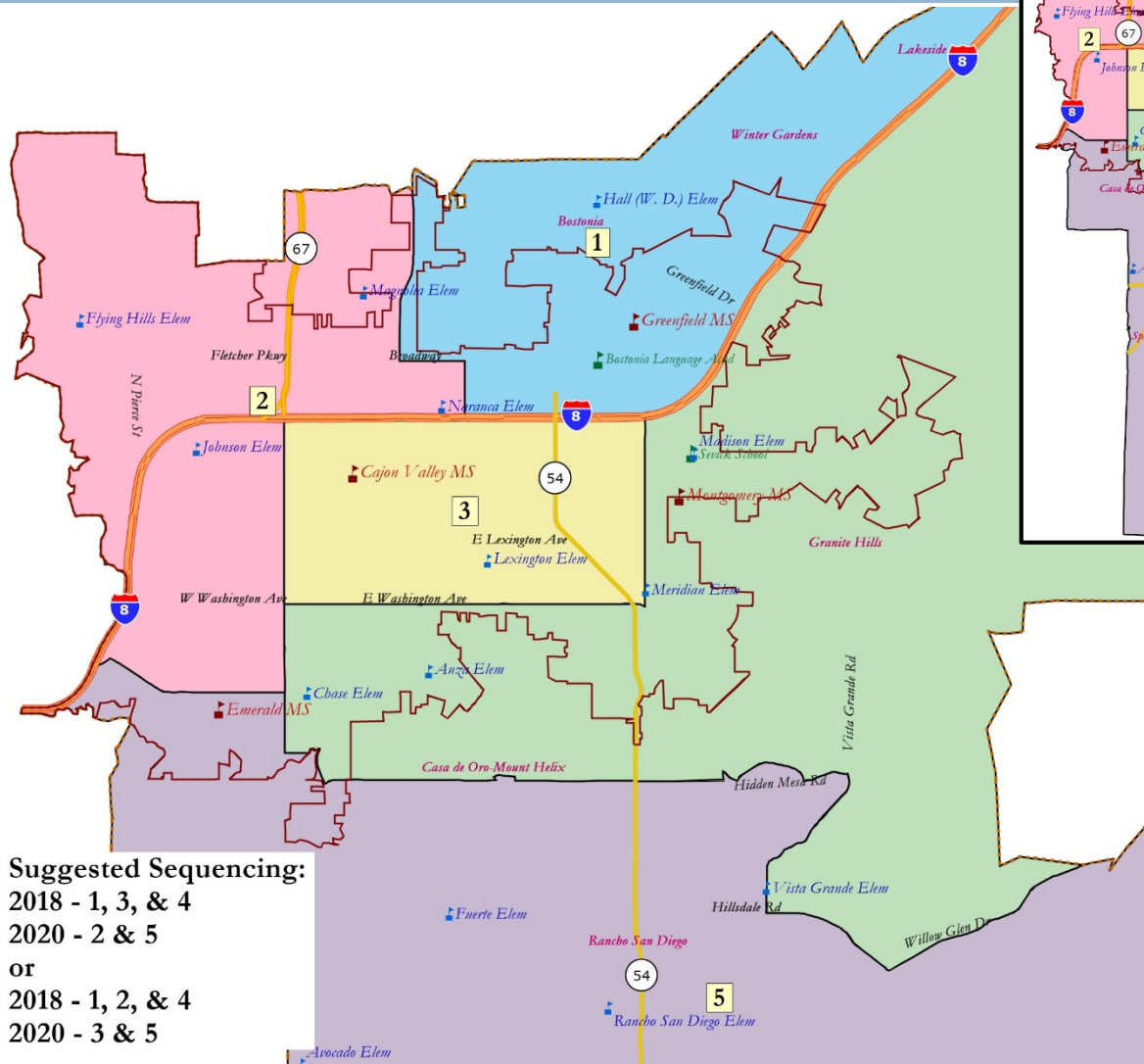

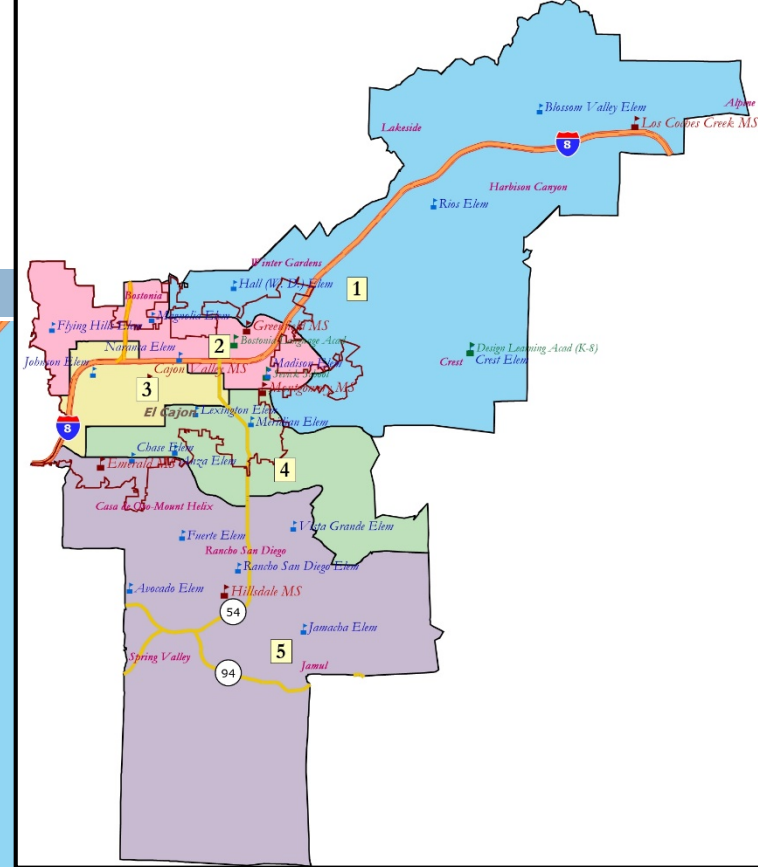
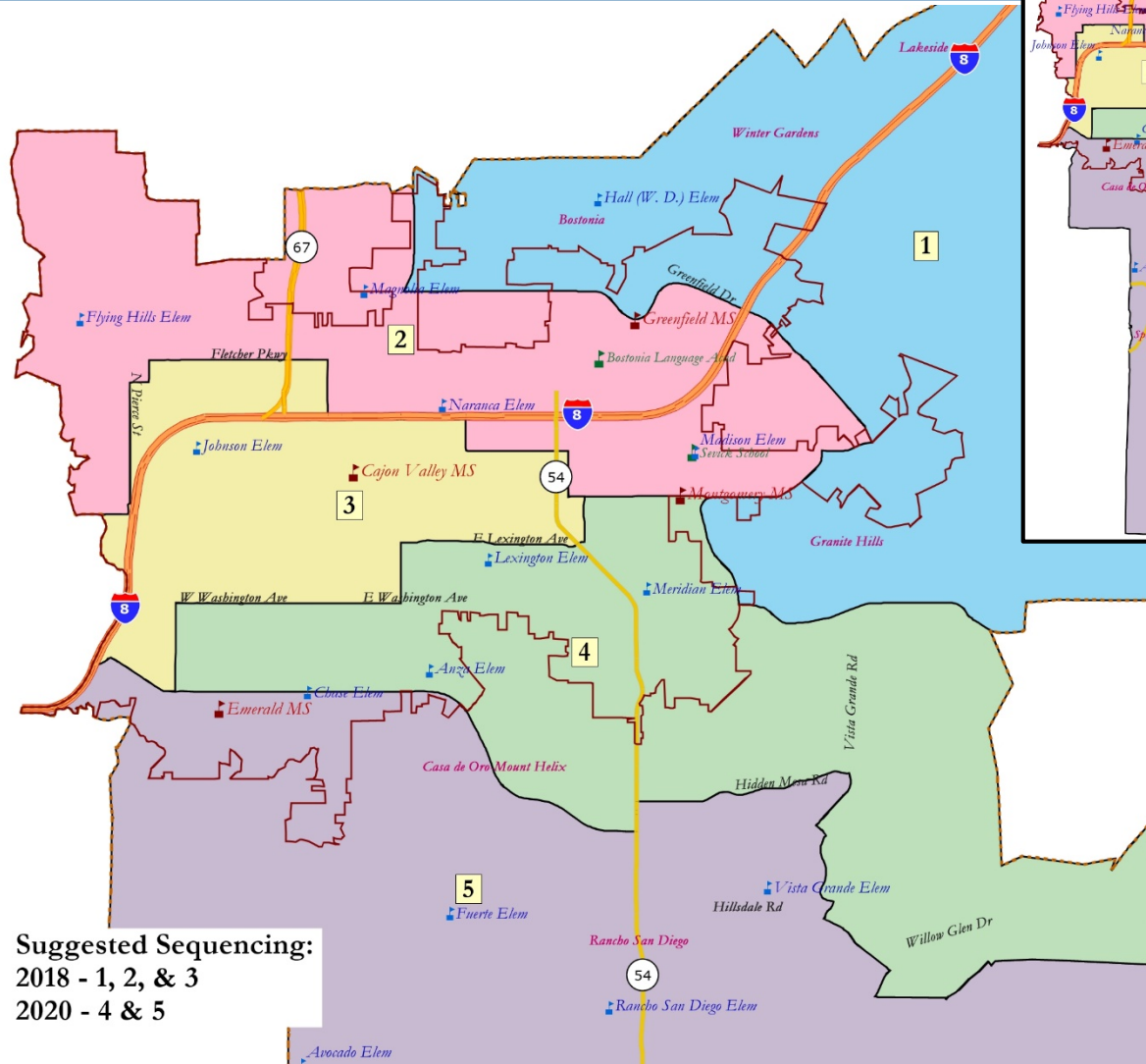

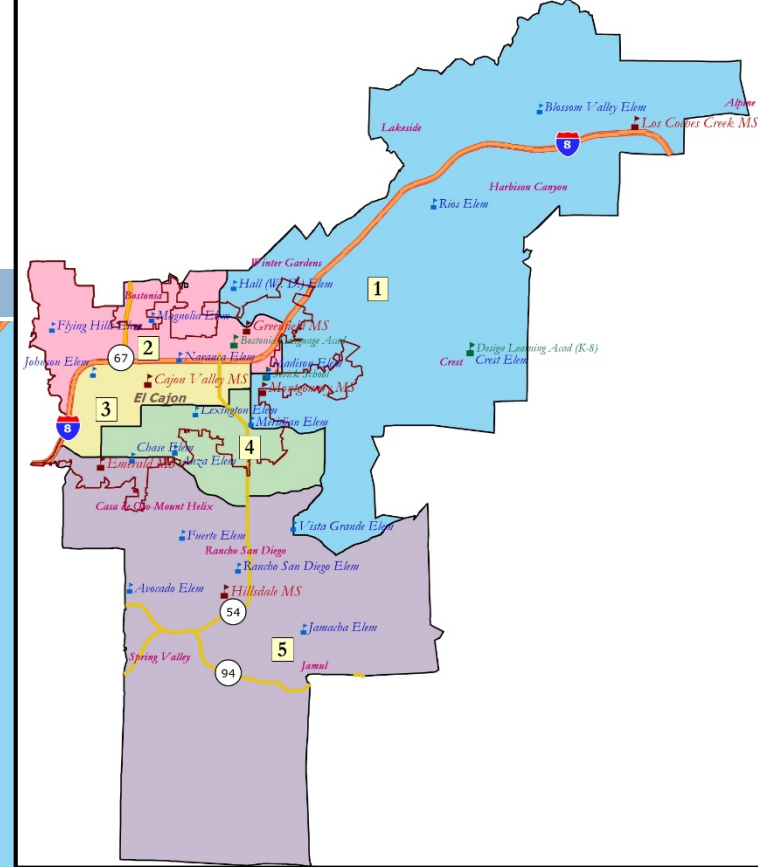
