Forester

The great kapok tree: a tale of the Amazon Rain Forest (Literature Set) [50675]
The many different animals that live in a great kapok tree in the Brazilian rain forest try to convince a man with an ax of the importance of not cutting down their home. RL 4.4. Includes 24 books.

Kate Sessions (Kit) [50480]

Introduces local San Diego history through Kate Sessions and her contribution to San Diego and Balboa Park. Contains five (5) historical photographs, two (2) books and one (1) The gardens of Balboa Park map. THE TREE LADY: THE TRUE STORY OF HOW ONE TREE-LOVING WOMAN CHANGED A CITY FOREVER, by Joseph Hopkins: Tells the true story of Katherine Olivia Sessions, the first woman to graduate from the University of California with a degree in science, who brought trees to San Diego and helped create what eventually became Balboa Park. Nominated for 2015-2016 California Young Reader Medal in the “picture book for older readers” category. (RL 4.5; 760 Lexile) KATE SESSIONS: THE MOTHER OF BALBOA PARK, by Joy Raab Charming: Illustrations and simple text allows readers young and old to appreciate a woman instrumental in the development of one of the world’s great urban parks. Includes maps and drawing of trees that Kate Sessions introduced that can be seen today in Balboa Park. Contains: 2 books / 5 photographs (11x14) / 1 map / 1 teacher's guide for book: The tree lady.

Pine life history (Realia) [35011]

Includes male cone; first, second and third year female cones; ripe seed; and twigs with leaves. Actual specimens encased in plastic. 3 3/4"x 4 3/4".

Skeletonized leaf for venation (Realia) [35006]

Preparation of a magnolia leaf, stained to show network of veins. Actual specimen encased in plastic. 3 3/4"x 4 3/4".

Wood specimens (Realia) [35025]

These wood samples were secured from the slopes, foothills and high country of our Rocky Mountains. Set of 24 specimens / 1 teacher's guide.

Yosemite: inspiration for conservation (DVD) [81154]

Describes Yosemite's ecosystem and geological wonders, the historical and contemporary efforts to preserve the sequoia trees, and the value of the work done by John Muir and Ansel Adams in the establishment and protection of the park. Includes teacher's guide. 20 min.

Zoologist

Animals in the wild (Literature Set) [50255]

Contains 4 titles: ANIMAL FACT/ANIMAL FABLE, written by Seymour Simon, describes common beliefs about animals and explains which are fact and which are fable. Covers such beliefs as bats are blind (fable), and some fish can climb trees (fact). BEAR, written by Mary Hoffman, and KOALA and PENGUIN, written by Vincent Serventy, each describe the life and habitat of the animal, with emphasis on its struggle for survival. RL 1-3.
