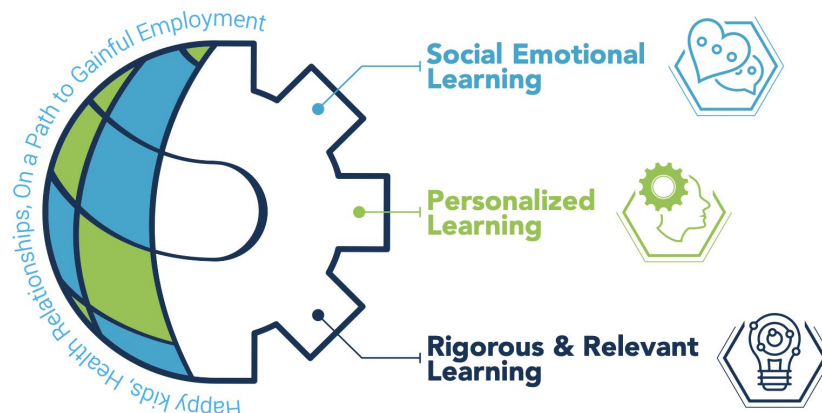

Distance Learning Fall 2020



Distance Learning in Fall of 2020 for Cajon Valley Union School District and Johnson Elementary will look and feel different from Spring of 2020 Emergency Distance Learning. Spring Distance Learning was an emergency response due to the sudden closure of our schools.

This Fall, teachers will be providing a rigorous curriculum for your child based on content area standards and individual needs. Assignments will be graded by the teacher and feedback provided on progress. All students will take a diagnostic assessment for both ELA and Math in iReady to determine their current skill level. Staff will provide personalized, standards based instruction to support and monitor growth throughout the year.

Students must attend zoom meetings with their teacher and class. Students must complete assignments provided by the teacher. Time in zoom classes and time completing independent assignments will be counted and applied to the student's daily instructional minutes. These instructional minutes are required by the State of California.

Q	When does school start?







Q	Will there be food service at Johnson Elementary
A	<p>Student lunches will be provided in the Johnson School parking lot from 11:00 to 1:00 each day, Monday - Friday, beginning on the first day of school, August 19th.</p>  <p>Food bags from Feeding San Diego will be available for pick-up on Thursdays from 11:00 - 1:00 beginning on August 27th.</p>

Q	What's the best way to contact my child's teacher or school staff?
A	<p>There are several ways to contact your child's teacher once the school year begins:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You may call the office and leave a message for your child's teacher between the hours of 7:30 and 3:00. 619-588-3139 • We highly recommend you download ParentSquare onto your smart phone so you can message the teacher directly and stay informed about school happenings. • Please read all teacher communications. Each teacher will let you know the best method of contact.   

Q	How will attendance be taken during the school year?
A	<p>During the 2020-21 school year, attendance will be taken daily. Students are responsible for attending all live teacher sessions with their cameras turned on. Due to the state attendance requirements, our staff must be able to identify students present during the live sessions. In order to document daily attendance, students will need to display their videos during all live class sessions throughout their day.</p> <p>In addition, students will be given time-valued assignments by their teacher(s). Students will be given attendance credit for completing these assignments and attending their live instructional sessions.</p> <p>We highly suggest students wake up at least an hour before school starts, get dressed, gather their school supplies, and eat breakfast before 9:00 am each day. Treating the start of the day like any other school day will help students get into the right mindset and take their studies seriously.</p> <div data-bbox="375 848 1419 1079" style="text-align: center;"></div>

Q	How will my child be graded?
A	<p>Students will be receiving feedback on their progress and grades from their individual teachers. Progress reports or report cards will be provided every six weeks. Please don't hesitate to contact your child's teacher with any questions you may have throughout the year.</p> <div data-bbox="824 1625 971 1780" style="text-align: center;"></div>

Q	What counseling services are available? How do I contact a counselor?
A	<p>Our School Counselor is Ms. Lemus, and our School Guidance Technician is Ms. Misola. Here is the counseling website link. On the website you will find their contact information and a list of their services.</p> <p>If you need to talk to a counselor, fill out the HELP SLIP and a counselor will get back to you by the next business day.</p> 

Q	What if my child receives Special Education services?
A	<p>Special Education services will also be delivered via Distance Learning. All of our service providers will work with children online. If your child has an Individualized Education Plan (IEP), the case manager will be contacting you.</p>

Q	Will Distance Learning this Fall be like Spring?
A	<p>No. Spring Distance Learning was an emergency response due to the sudden closures of our schools. This Fall, teachers will be providing a rigorous curriculum for your child based on content area standards and individual needs. Assignments will be graded by the teacher and feedback provided on progress. All students will take a diagnostic assessment for both ELA and Math to determine their current skill level.
