PLANNERS are an important part of being successful. It is our way of communicating with you and your parents, and it is imperative that you have your planner with you daily and that it is correctly filled out.

BE IN CLASS ON TIME DAILY. This means be in your seat and ready to work when the bell rings.

When **ABSENT**, check your planner, call a study buddy, or check the websites.

REWARD ACTIVITIES will occur once per trimester for students who receive A's and B's in all areas on their report card.

BATHROOM PASSES (6) will be issued once per trimester to be used in any core class. If these passes are not used, they may be turned in at the end of the trimester for extra credit. It is your responsibility to keep these passes and to present them to your teacher in order for you to use the bathroom and to receive the extra credit at the end of the trimester.

SUSTAINED SILENT READING is a requirement of **0 PERIOD**. Students are required to have independent reading materials. Books and electronic reading devices are acceptable. Students will not be allowed to use phones as a reading device. Misuse of electronic reading devices will eliminate student's privilege. A passing grade for 0 Period is partially determined by SSR.
